Rice Memorial Scholarship Application Procedure

Guidelines

- To be eligible for the West Side Presbyterian Church (WSPC) Rice Scholarship applicants must meet all of the requirements.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered for evaluation.
- Applications must be submitted in hard copy format and have authentic original signatures.

Requirements

- Must be a member of WSPC who is active in the life of the church, or young person active in the youth program of WSPC. While attending college/university/seminary regularly attending worship at a local church. (Minimum two times per month.)
- Must be a full-time student.
- Must be attending a 4 year evangelical Christian college/university, evangelical Christian graduate school, or evangelical Christian theological seminary.
- Completed application and supporting materials are due in to West Side Presbyterian Church office by **April 15, 2020 (4:00pm)**. If you prefer to submit your completed application and support materials via mail, the package must be **postmarked by April 14, 2020**.

Application Summary (all materials must be submitted at one time)

- All applications must be **typed** or **clearly printed** in blue or black ink.
- **Every blank** in the scholarship application **must be completed**. This includes complete addresses and zip codes. If a particular portion of the application does not apply to the applicant, **N/A** should be placed on the blank.
- All applications **must include a copy of your high school transcript or college transcript for the first quarter/semester of the current school year and of the previous school year**.
- Applicants must submit **two (2) letters of recommendation** (recommenders cannot be related to applicant or be serving on the WSPC Scholarship Committee or currently serving as an elder).
- **Include the two (2) letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes with your completed application and transcript.**

Policies/Procedures

- The committee will evaluate each applicant based on the above procedures.
- Scholarships will be awarded annually provided the funds are available.
- Re-application is necessary each year.
- The number of scholarships awarded is limited and is NOT solely based on level or length of involvement at West Side.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered for evaluation; additional information will not be requested or entertained.
- Understand that some committee members may not know you...answer questions carefully and thoughtfully. This is your opportunity to shine.
