ARRIVAL:

Each morning, doors open at 9 am and your camper(s) may check-in at one of the four stations in the Cafe Area.

Please keep your security tag as you will need it to sign out your child after camp.

If you have any special instructions for our camp staff, please be sure to let them know at this time. Any unregistered campers will need to be registered and then assigned to a group.

DISMISSAL:

Please park in the main parking lot and come in to pick up your camper. You will need your child's security tag to present to a staff member before they can release your child.

DON'T FORGET: Saturday is Family Day!! Meet first at The Foundation Church and at 11am we arrive at Rec Center Pool.

Camper Check-In – Each morning, you will need to go to the check-in area to sign-in your child(ren) and get their security tag.

Under-the-Sea Opening Assembly – This includes a fun time of opening each day with prayer, worship, and learning a little about what the day is to bring.

Lifesaver Lesson Time – Presenting the day's Bible lesson and focus that goes along with the theme.

Craft/Snacks Rotation - Includes guiding campers through making creative crafts, fun snacks, and bathroom break.

LUNCH – HIGH5 Camp is all-day and you will need to pack a disposable lunch and water bottle. Please label everything your child will be bringing. There are water stations available if needed.

Games - Include fun, active, and exciting non-water games.

Splish! Splash! Games - Includes water and getting wet. You may want your camper to wear a bathing suit under clothes, bring a towel, or a change of clothes for your camper.

Bible Verse - Includes campers learning and experiencing a few of our missionaries in different countries. Campers are encouraged to support our missionaries through prayer and if able, financially.

Sunsational Science Lab - Hands-on science activities that are FUN and also a meaningful way to reinforce key concepts from each day's lesson.

Each day, the counselors will help the campers learn their verses. We invite you to learn and help your camper too. Their team will receive points for each verse that is memorized and said by each camper.

MISSION MOMENT CHALLENGE

We are partnering with Children's Hunger Fund to provide meals for "Food Paks." Local churches in a variety of countries will use these parcels of food to deliver the hope of the gospel to the homes of suffering children. Each day, campers will meet three kids in need of food and the gospel.

Every dollar given during HIGH5 Camp will provide four meals for hungry kids. Each meal represents an opportunity to proclaim the gospel! There will be a challenge to see what age group raises the most. The winner will be revealed on Sunday during the service.
