What is ACCS Accreditation and What will it do for Libertas Christian School?

Libertas Christian School is soon beginning the journey toward ACCS Accreditation. But what exactly is "accreditation?" Considering that many, if not most, successful Christian, and even classical Christian schools are not accredited, why is Libertas undergoing this process? Why weren't we already accredited? Doesn't a school have to be accredited for my student to get into college? These are a few of the questions that might go through the minds of parents when they hear "ACCS accreditation." While it is true that our graduates acquire entrance into a variety of colleges and programs with ease, without our being accredited (as many schools are not), accreditation through the ACCS (Association of Classical Christian Schools) adds a "feather in our cap," so to speak. It is an avenue through which Libertas can pursue truth, goodness and beauty to the glory of God by offering a truly superior spiritual and academic program. Once accredited through the ACCS, Libertas will be considered among the less than 20% of over 300 classical Christian ACCS member schools to receive this prestigious recognition. According to the ACCS website, "ACCS accreditation is a school-improvement program that provides an evaluation of a school and its practices to encourage stability, quality, and a measure of excellence." Through this process we will be evaluating and updating systems already in place and creating new ones as necessary. The "Road to Accreditation" is a rigorous 5 step undertaking. We will first need to apply to become an accreditation candidate, then host a pre-visit with the ACCS Director of Accreditation, successfully complete a self-study that is approved by the Director, host an Accreditation Site Team visit and finally, wait for an

accreditation decision. The end result of this journey will include, but is not limited to, details such as a fully developed scope and sequence for each class, updated policy manuals for the Board, staff and families, a strategic plan for finances, facilities, staff development & training, etc. Many of these things we already do really well! This accreditation process will allow Libertas to grow and excel in many areas, but this is no small task.

Because of the thorough nature of this endeavor, we are confident, the school will reach a new level of excellence that will further set us apart from traditional and other classical Christian schools. Most classical Christian schools seeking this "gold standard" are ready to apply for accreditation 7-10 years after opening, so Libertas is right on par with that timeline. Stay tuned for further updates as to how we will achieve this and what the Libertas accreditation process will entail. Be encouraged at this exciting opportunity!

The 2021-2022 school year has begun. Students fill the hallway with laughter and diligence. Friendships and connections are growing everywhere you look.

As I reflect on this time of year and praise the Lord for his provision for not only my children, but all of the students he has sent to Libertas, He also brings to mind you, the Libertas supporters.

Last spring, at the annual Legacy Gala, you were presented with 3 giving opportunites to help our school be more effective in ministering to the students. They were bathroom renovations, internet upgrade, and new drinking fountains/water stations. Thanks to you, we have been able to fully fund two of the three projects!

As of August 2021, we now have two new water stations/drinking fountains; one set in the grammar school area, and one set in the upper school area. The students are able to easily fill water bottles with a touchless unit, or use a traditional bubbler to get a drink. This has been a fun new experience. The

water is also filtered, which makes it taste much better than before. What a blessing it is to have easily accessible, clean water. Thank you!

The second project that was fully funded is the installation of fiberoptic internet services. We have been waiting all summer for the internet provider to get construction scheduled and completed. The original completion date was Sept. 9, but has now been moved to Sept. 24. Then they will schedule the final install



of the service. We hope to have the job complete by Oct. 1. The faculty, staff, and students are all ready for this upgrade to take place. Everyone is grateful for this provision.

The final project that has not been

fully funded as of yet is the renovations of the grammar school bathrooms. At this point we have collected approximately \$12,000 of the \$53,000 needed to do the full remodel. We are planning to revisit this project as it is important to have clean, healthy facilities for our students and guests. Watch for more opportunites to come to support this project.

While these special projects are wonderful and enhance our school greatly, the ministry of Libertas Christian School relies on Legacy Partners on a daily basis. We are not able to charge enough in tuition to pay the cost of operating the school. Legacy Partners help fill in the gap of funding the general operations of Libertas.

Legacy Partners are parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, friends, or acquaintences who support classical Christian education and want to support you! Libertas is a 501c3 organization, which means your donations are tax deductible. Legacy Partners can give in honor of a student, in memory of a lost loved one, or just in general. 
