



Libertas Christian School Enhanced Health & Safety Plan 2020 - 2021

ILLNESS

From time to time your child may become ill during the school year. Here are illness management guidelines from the Ottawa County Health Department, as they relate to school. Please see attached flow chart.

1. If your child becomes ill during the school day, the school secretary will contact the parent at the phone numbers that have been provided so the child can be taken home.
2. If your child has a fever, diarrhea, or is throwing up, he/she will not be allowed to return to school until he/she is symptom free without medication for 24 hours.
3. If your child has strep throat, he/she may not return to school unless he/she has been taking strep medication for 24 hours.
4. Classroom parents will be notified if a peer in their child's classroom is diagnosed by a physician with a highly communicable disease such as chicken pox, measles, COVID-19, whooping cough, etc. Their child's classroom would undergo additional cleaning and disinfecting.
5. Adhering to these guidelines may reduce the transmission of illness at school.

HANDWASHING

Handwashing throughout the day, i.e. prior to and following snacks, lunch, recess, bathroom breaks, etc.

Daily room cleaning: A CDC approved cleaning solution will be used in Libertas classrooms for disinfecting desks and door handles.

Grammar and Upper School: Teachers will conduct end-of-the day cleaning for each of their rooms, which includes wiping down desks and door handles.

MASKS

If so desired, parents may choose to send their children to school with masks. However, Libertas faculty, staff and administration are not required to enforce the wearing of masks.
