1. Read together Hebrews 10:19-25 together. What does it mean that we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus? Why is this a powerful reminder for us in our current circumstances?
2. Read Hebrews 10:35-39 together. In what ways are we in danger of “throwing away our confidence” (v.35) or “shrinking back” (v.39)? How might God be using our current circumstances to grow endurance?
3. Read Hebrews 11:1 together. When are you most confident and assured of what you hope for in Christ? What causes your faith to “shrink”?
4. What are some of the ways that you believe God might be using the current circumstances to increase your faith? Specifically, how are you currently experiencing God’s presence and provision?
5. Read Hebrews 11:3-6 together. Why do you think the writer of Hebrews says, “And without faith it is impossible to please God”? (Hint: meditate on the second half of v.6)
6. Gratitude is the language of faith. Take some time as a group or as a family to thank God for His provision and presence which He is revealing through this crisis
