Luke 10: 25-37 - The Parable of The Good Samaritan

What is the best definition of a parable?
A short allegorical story designed to illustrate or teach some truth, religious principle, or moral lesson.

Characters relative to this parable

Lawyer - An expert in the Mosaic law -

You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the Lord. Lev. 19:18

Priest — A Holy man —

From Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, 6 and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. Rev. 1:5-6

Levite — Tribe separated for service to the Lord

At that time the Lord separated the tribe of Levi to bear the ark of the covenant of the Lord, to stand before the Lord to minister to Him and to bless in His name, to this day. Deut. 10:8

Samaritian — a member of a people inhabiting Samaria in biblical times, or of the modern community in the region of Nablus claiming descent from them, adhering to a form of Judaism accepting only its own ancient version of the Pentateuch as Scripture.

Despised, ridiculed, put down, and we are better than them.
