


O Jesus in the Story


② A Verse from the Story to Learn at Home

Notes for parents: From the story we learned that even though we don't always love God, he always loves us. Cod has a plan to solve the problem of sin, and the plan is Jesus.

Please help your child to memorize the verse and the Scripture reference for next time. Please review with the place of the book of Genesis, using the diagram above.





Do you ever feel sad, lonely, sick or afraid? Write down a time you felt this way!

That is how it all changed. The world was perfect and then the world stopped being perfect. **One little lie broke everything!** Adam and Eve believed a lie -- the lie that God did not love them and that they didn't need God. And that lie is still being repeated today.

- Do you ever hear or think about this lie? Do you ever feel like no one loves you, or like you aren't good enough, pretty enough, or smart enough?
- Are there times when you just want to do things your own way?
 Journal your thoughts about these questions.

Sin breaks everything. Our thoughts about God, about ourselves and about other people are sometimes not good; they are broken. The way we treat other people sometimes is not good; our friendships are broken. And all around us bad things happen; creation is broken.

But this story is still about what <u>God</u> has done! Even after sin broke everything, God still looked for his children because he loved them. **God** still loves us! That very same day God whispered a promise to Adam & Eve; he promised to come and rescue them. And he did!

- Last lesson we read about how God feels about us and who he made us to be. Go back and review. What does God think about you?
- Read **Psalm 139 and Zephaniah 3:17**. What does the Bible tell you about how God really feels? What is true about you, and what is a lie?
