



## BUILDING RE-ENTRY PLAN

After considering all possibilities, with future viability weighing heavily in our decision, this is the Phase 3: Building Reentry Plan, in 2 parts:

### Part 1: Combination 3 Indoor Worship Services + 1 Outdoor Worship Service – Starting September 13

- 8 am Indoor Worship in the Sanctuary
- 9:30 am Worship on the Ball Field
- 11 am Indoor Worship Service in the Sanctuary with Worship Care for Birth-Pre-K
- 5 pm Indoor Worship with overflow in MPR (if necessary)

### Part 2: All Indoor Worship Services with Sunday School – Starting November 1

- 8 am Worship Service in Sanctuary with Worship Care for Birth-Pre-K
  - 9:30am Worship Service in MPR/Sunday School with FABC Kids Sunday School
  - 11 am Worship Service in Sanctuary with Worship Care for Birth-Pre-K
  - 5 pm Worship Service in the Sanctuary, with overflow in MPR, and Worship Care for Birth-Pre-k
- ✚ All Indoor Worship Services will require reservations. The sanctuary can accommodate 28 families in each service.
  - ✚ All FABC Kids and Volunteers will be health screened prior to attending or serving in any FABC Kids programming. This will include a health questionnaire and temperature check. Parents and church members will no longer be allowed to pick up and drop off at the classroom or utilize the FABC Kids hallways.

### Why:

- **Service Times** – A later service schedule would make it too difficult to offer Sunday School and it be successful during the morning schedule.
- **Alternating Locations** – This allows us to adequately clean spaces between uses and reduce foot traffic and congestion throughout the campus.
- **Reservations** – Reservations will allow us to make sure that we are adequately staffed for Worship Care and allow us to ensure that Social Distancing is followed in all services.
- **FABC Kids Health Screenings** - Our screening tool is the same tool that is used by all licensed child care facilities in the state of North Carolina.
- **Limited Building Access** – Since all FABC Kids and Volunteers will go through a health screening process, the hallways and classrooms will only be accessed by approved staff and FABC Kids Volunteers. We have created 2 FABC Kids Check-In/Out Stations that will be used for this purpose. Partitions will be set up to prevent accidental access.
  - Limited Access to the FABC Kids Preschool Hallway will continue after our other Covid19 precautions are no longer necessary, due to general safety and security measures.

## How:

- **Phase 3, Part 1:**
  - **8 am Indoor Worship**
    - Social Distancing and masks are required at all times inside the building.
    - Reservations will be required (We will not completely book all seats, to accommodate those who may not know about the need for reservations.).
    - Enter through the back of the sanctuary only.
    - Following the service, all doors will be closed and the sanctuary will be cleaned using a Commander Tri-Jet Fogger and the EPA-approved, Buckeye® Sani-Q™ Sanitizing Solution. This will ensure that the sanctuary is sanitized between services.
  - **9:30 am Worship on the Ball Field**
    - Social Distancing and masks are required when social distancing is not able to be maintained (essentially any time that you are outside your box).
  - **11 am Indoor Worship Service with Worship Care for Birth-Pre-K**
    - Social Distancing and masks are required throughout the service.
    - Reservations will be required (We will not completely book all seats, to accommodate those who may not know about the need for reservations.).
    - Enter through the back of the sanctuary only.
    - Worship Care will be provided for birth-Pre-K children.
      - Reservations are required to ensure proper protocols can be met.
      - Check In/Out will be at the **Jefferson** Portico entrance. Only FABC Kids and Volunteers will be allowed to use that entrance.
      - Health Screenings will be required for all FABC Kids and Volunteers.
    - Following the service, all doors will be closed and the sanctuary will be cleaned using a Commander Tri-Jet Fogger and the EPA-approved, Buckeye® Sani-Q™ Sanitizing Solution. This will ensure that the sanctuary is sanitized between services.
  - **5 pm Indoor Worship with overflow in MPR (if necessary)**
    - Social Distancing and masks are required at all times inside the building.
    - Reservations will be required (We will not completely book all seats, to accommodate those who may not know about the need for reservations.).
    - Enter through the back of the sanctuary only.
    - Following the service, all doors will be closed and the sanctuary will be cleaned using a Commander Tri-Jet Fogger and the EPA-approved, Buckeye® Sani-Q™ Sanitizing Solution. This will ensure that the sanctuary is sanitized between services.

## Phase 3, Part 2:

- **8 am Worship Service in the Sanctuary with Worship Care for Birth-Pre-K**
  - Social Distancing and masks are required at all times inside the building.
  - Reservations will be required (We will not completely book all seats, to accommodate those who may not know about the need for reservations.).
  - Enter through the back of the sanctuary only.
  - You can exit through the front of the sanctuary; however, total access of the building will not be permitted. Access to all Youth and Adult Sunday School classes is available.

- Elevator use will be restricted to those who have to use the elevators (i.e. not for general public use). Those wishing to use the elevator will need to use the Ministry Center Elevator and will have to be escorted into the building by someone on the FABC Kids Check In/Out Team.
- Worship Care will be provided for birth-Pre-K children.
  - Reservations are required to ensure proper protocols can be met.
  - Check In/Out will be at the **Jefferson** Portico entrance. Only FABC Kids and Volunteers will be allowed to use that entrance.
  - Health Screenings will be required for all FABC Kids and Volunteers.
- Following the service, all doors will be closed and the sanctuary will be cleaned using a Commander Tri-Jet Fogger and the EPA-approved, Buckeye® Sani-Q™ Sanitizing Solution. This will ensure that the sanctuary is sanitized between services.
- **9:30 am Worship Service in MPR/Sunday School with Sunday School**
  - Social Distancing and masks are required at all times inside the building.
  - Reservations will be required (We will not completely book all seats, to accommodate those who may not know about the need for reservations.).
  - Enter through the MPR door closest to Westridge. *The Westridge Portico entrance will be for FABC Kids only.*
  - Elevator use will be restricted to those who have to use the elevators (i.e. not for general public use). Those wishing to use the elevator will need to use the Ministry Center Elevator and will have to be escorted in the building by someone on the FABC Kids Check In/Out Team.
  - Sunday School will be provided for all FABC Kids.
    - Reservations are required to ensure proper protocols can be met.
    - Check In/Out will be at the **Westridge** Portico entrance. Only FABC Kids and Volunteers will be allowed to use that entrance.
    - Health Screenings will be required for all FABC Kids and Volunteers.
    - Preschool Sunday School Classes will be moved to the Ministry Center Classrooms and Ark Area.
      - MC 101 (3 C's Class) – Infants/Crawlers
      - MC 102 (All Seasons/Sowers Class) – Toddlers and 2's
      - MC 103 (Connect Class) – 3's & Pre-K
      - Access from the MPR to Ark area will be prohibited and the bathrooms will be for **FABC Kids ONLY**.
      - Any child who has been registered for Sunday School and for the 11 am Worship Service will be moved to their classroom on the FABC Kids Preschool Hallway at the end of Sunday School. All other children and all Grade School children will need to be picked up under the **Westridge** portico at the end of Sunday School.
      - There will be partitions blocking access:
        - Down the main hallway from the Jefferson Portico entrance.
          - To enter the building for Sunday School you will need to use the Friendly Avenue entrance, the Sanctuary entrance (at the conclusion of the service), the breezeway entrance between the Preschool Hallway and the MPR or the MPR door closest to Westridge.

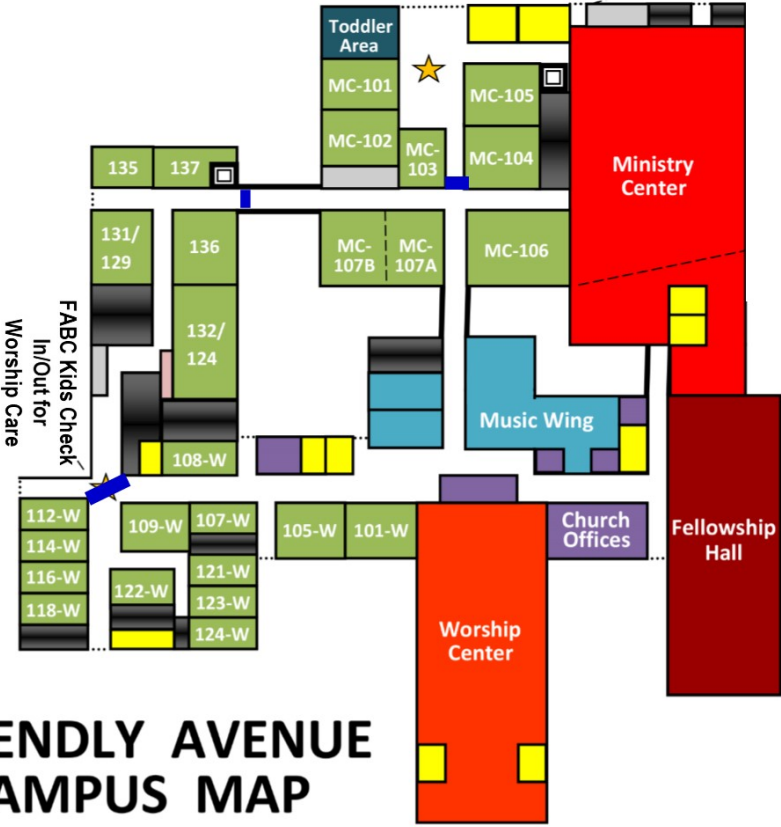
- At the intersection between the Conference Room and the Pastor's Connect Class to prevent access into the FABC Kids Area.
- The Preschool Hallway will only be accessed with a key fob by FABC Kids Staff/Volunteers.
- The doors leading from the MPR to the Ark Area to protect our children. There are bathrooms available on the other side of the new kitchen.
- **11 am Worship Service in the Sanctuary with Worship Care for Birth-Pre-K**
  - Social Distancing and masks are required at all times inside the building.
  - Reservations will be required (We will not completely book all seats, to accommodate those who may not know about the need for reservations.).
  - People just attending the 11am Worship Service will need to enter through the back of the sanctuary.
  - Worship Care will be provided for birth-Pre-K children.
    - Reservations are required to ensure proper protocols can be met.
    - Check In/Out will be at the **Jefferson** Portico entrance. Only FABC Kids and Volunteers will be allowed to use that entrance.
    - Health Screenings will be required for all FABC Kids and Volunteers.
  - Following the service, all doors will be closed and the sanctuary will be cleaned using a Commander Tri-Jet Fogger and the EPA-approved, Buckeye® Sani-Q™ Sanitizing Solution. This will ensure that the sanctuary is sanitized between services.
- **5 pm Worship Service in the Sanctuary, with overflow in MPR, and Worship Care for Birth-Pre-K**
  - Social Distancing and masks are required at all times inside the building.
  - Reservations will be required (We will not completely book all seats, to accommodate those who may not know about the need for reservations.).
  - *The Westridge Portico entrance will be for FABC Kids only.*
  - Elevator use will be restricted to those who have to use the elevators (i.e. not for general public use). Those wishing to use the elevator will need to use the Ministry Center Elevator and will have to be escorted in the building by someone on the FABC Kids Check In/Out Team.
  - Reservations are required to ensure proper protocols can be met.
  - Check In/Out will be at the **Westridge** Portico entrance. Only FABC Kids and Volunteers will be allowed to use that entrance.
  - Health Screenings will be required for all FABC Kids and Volunteers.
  - Preschool Classes will be moved to the Ministry Center Classrooms and Ark Area.
    - MC 101 (3 C's Class) – Infants/Crawlers
    - MC 102 (All Seasons/Sowers Class) – Toddlers and 2's
    - MC 103 (Connect Class) – 3's & Pre-K
  - Access from the MPR to Ark area will be prohibited and the bathrooms will be for **FABC Kids ONLY**.
  - There will be partitions blocking access:
    - Down the main hallway from the Jefferson Portico entrance.
      - To enter the building for Sunday School you will need to use the Friendly Avenue entrance, the Sanctuary entrance (at the conclusion of the service), the breezeway entrance between the Preschool Hallway and the MPR or the MPR door closest to Westridge.

- At the intersection between the Conference Room and the Pastor's Connect Class to prevent access into the FABC Kids Area.
- The Preschool Hallway will only be accessed with a key fob by FABC Kids Staff/Volunteers.
- The doors leading from the MPR to the Ark Area to protect our children. There are bathrooms available on the other side of the new kitchen.

**Needs:**

- **Ample Volunteers:**
  - Worship Care is a volunteer-based ministry and can only be provided if we have enough volunteers.
    - At a minimum, we will need 6 volunteers per service, plus a Check In/Out Team.
