1. Depression does not mean you lack faith – great men and women of God have struggled with anxiety and depression (1 Kings 17-19)

2. There are times when we're more vulnerable to anxiety or depression (1 Kings 18:1-19:10)

- When you are physically and emotionally fatigued
- The immediate aftermath of great "successes" or "failures"
- When dealing with constant problems
- When isolated and lonely

3. God will use our greatest struggles to get our attention (1 King. 19:11)

4. God's presence comes near, and His voice is gentle in times of great hurt (1 Kings 19:12)

5. God whispers three truths in times of depression (1 Kings 19:15-18; Isaiah 43:2)

- "I'm not done with you" (1 Kings 19:15)
- "You are not alone in your struggle" (1 Kings 19:18)
- "I will get you through this difficult time" (Isaiah 43:2)

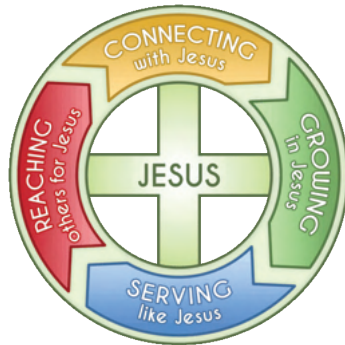
