VBS VOLUNTEERS WANTED

No matter the role you choose, we provide easy to follow instructions and all the supplies you need.

- <u>Sing 'n Sprout Teacher</u> (Sing 'n Sprout will happen in the nursery)-Job Description: Sing, play instruments, wiggle and giggle! The Sing N Sprout Curriculum is ready and full of Bible lessons, songs, games and fun for little ones. We just need a teacher! We'll provide everything you need including fun instruments! You sing, smile and play with parents and kids.
- <u>3yo, Preschool & Kindergarten Director-</u> Job Description: This organized and patient leader oversees the preschool crew. Think of them as the go-to person for all of the preschool kids and kids going into Kindergarten. Heather will take care of supplies and organization, but this person will be sure things run smoothly throughout the week at VBS. It can be one person or a team of 2.
- <u>3yo, Preschool & Kindergarten Craft Leader</u>-Job Description: This organized and energetic leader guides groups of preschoolers and kindergarteners through creating a variety of Bible point reinforcing crafts. The lesson is all written out and provided to you with all the supplies needed. We already have a helper signed up.
- 3yo, Preschool & Kindergarten Crew Leader- We need two more to fill our total of six of them! (a) It is for all of the kids age 3 through those going into Kindergarten! Job Description: The crew leader will lead a crew of small groups of preschool age kids. There's no preparation required. A preschool good crew leader is a friend and helper for the kids and station leaders. They ask questions, take kids seriously and encourage them throughout VBS. If you want to be with your own child or grandchild, please note that too.
- 3yo, Preschool & Kindergarten Crew HELPER- We two more to fill our total need of six of them! © It is for all of the kids age 3 through those going into Kindergarten! Job Description: You will be paired up with a crew leader who will lead a crew of small groups of preschool and kindergarten age kids. There's no preparation required. If you are hoping to be the assistant for a certain crew leader, please note that so we get you paired up! If you want to be with your own child or grandchild, please note that too.
- <u>Bible Station Leader-</u> Grades 1-6-Job Description: The Bible Station Leader tells the kids all about God's love and the big idea we are learning from the Bible each evening. We provide the props, supplies and activities. You provide the heart! We already have a helper signed up.
- <u>Games Leader</u> 1-6th Grade- Job Description: This energetic and fun leader is in charge of leading groups of elementary age kids in fun physical activities and discussions. You don't need to be an Olympian, you just need to be organized, energetic and fun loving. We already have a helper signed up.
- <u>Craft Assistants Grades 1-6</u> (need 2 more) Job Description: The assistant craft leader aids the crafts leader in managing and preparing materials, clean up and guiding kids through the process of making a variety of crafts. We already have a leader and one helper signed up.
