Key Scriptures:

John 6

Main Idea: Choose Jesus to satisfy your soul forever

1. Don't chase after miracles, be close to the miracle-maker
2. Change your focus for new revelation
3. Turn from a temporary fix to a final solution.

Talk about it:

1. Discuss the question of whether our religious belief is our own personal opinion or an objective truth? What do you know from God's Word to support your point of view? What wrong or incomplete images of who God is have you had?
2. Google the 7 "I Am" statements from the gospel of John. Remember Pastor Kaye said they tell us **who Jesus is**, but they also are telling us **who He is to us, in relationship with us**. As you look at those statements, how could you explain to someone those metaphors from the way Jesus relates to you and is in your life?(ie. How has Jesus been bread, or light, in your life?) This is a great time to celebrate together the truth of who Jesus says He is to us.
3. Read John 6:25-20. Why was it so absurd that they asked him to see a sign at this point in his ministry, or just in this chapter? What evidence of God's power in your life have you seen in the past that helps you believe in who He is today, even when it's hard?
4. Read John 6:47-63. What are some of the places/who are the people you turn to find satisfaction or fulfill your needs that only Jesus can satisfy?
Take some time split into smaller groups of men and women. How do you see patterns of turning to something to that is only a temporary fix? Be honest, this is a place to confess and take growth steps!
