# The Weekly Prayer Focus

## *Walking in purposeful prosperity*

**Suggestions:** Start your day with meditation and keep a tablet and a pen for journaling. Soft worship songs/music that glorifies God are most helpful. Be still and know that I am God. Allow the Holy Spirit to lift us in meditation as we wait with, wait in, and wait upon our great God. Allow the Spirit of prayer and supplication to rest upon us. After all, men ought to always pray and not faint. **Try it if you haven’t already.**

Gods perspective of us changes everything and our perspective of us have to agree with his in order for us to walk in his purpose for our lives and experience his promises

### **Week 1:**

**Pray for clearer vision-**Ask God to open the eyes of our understanding to see ourselves as he sees us. Pray that we grasp his perspective so that we can live in his promises. Pray for a deeper relationship with God, a consistent prayer life. Pray that God reveals the mystery of Christ by the Holy Spirit. That we be strong in his might. That we be rooted and grounded in the love of Christ which passes knowledge; able to comprehend the width, length, depth and height and filled with all the fullness of God. Pray that we consistently walk in that understanding and cause our family and others to do likewise.

### **Week 2:**

#### **Read and Meditate on Ephesians chapters 1-3**

Ask God to place on the canvases of our imaginations how we can live above earth situations and overcome every obstacle according to the word of God. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you unlearn the path that leads to fear, doubt and a lack of trust as the word wash away the old man and open us up to new possibilities of how to walk in purpose. **Journal the nuggets from the word and the conversation with God**

### **Week 3:**

**Say What God Says:** Since we are speaking spirits created in the image and likeness of God, let’s agree with God and speak the things he says about us (**make your list and let’s make this week, “confession week”**).

**Suggestions:** I’m the healed that the enemy is trying to make sick, I will live in purpose and not die a premature death but finish. I have power, and the anointing to get wealth, I have faith and I am more than a conqueror therefore, I will not be defeated in any area of my life; spiritually, socially, morally, domestically, financially, and economically. I am wise and I win souls for the kingdom of God. Pray and believe those confessions will be manifested in our lives.

### **Week 4:**

#### **Act according to truth-**

Now that our lenses are changing, let’s make something happen for others this week. Pray for another’s ministry, healing, marriage, children, finances, souls, spiritual gifts and whoever and whatever the Holy Spirit brings to our hearts to pray. Pray it, believing that we all shall see the glory of God in our lives and homes, in our careers, churches, neighborhoods, cities states, and territories when His Kingdom comes and His will be done in earth as it already is in heaven
