## The Weekly Prayer Focus

## Hunger is a signal that God is setting you up for an encounter with Him!

"Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in him." (Psalm 34:8, NIV)

- Week 1: Pray for Pastor Mark, Lady Mary, children and families. Give thanks and honor as it is due him and Lady Mary. Pray provision for every vision.
