## The Weekly Prayer Focus

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanks-giving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:6-7

A little background of the Philippians 4:6-7: Paul's letter to the Philippians encourages us also not to allow our physical pains and conditions, our status in life or our surroundings to cheat us out of the good life Christ died for us to have. His encouragement came while he was suffering with great physical pain. He still admonished them and us to give thanks even while he was in prison, and he encourages his listeners to guard their hearts and minds, while he was isolated and alone.

Our faith can also stand the test of time but only if we stand connected to the vine/Christ Jesus, feed our spirit man through meditating on the word of God until it becomes alive in our hearts, lived out in our lives, and pray without ceasing. (The ACTS Model Prayers)

**Week 1:** Adoration: Respect, reverence, strong admiration, or love in a certain person, place, or thing. To honor, to adore; to idolize. God is to be worshipped and adored.

- · Meditate upon the Person, His promises, provisions, power, and surrender all to Him in...
- · Worship, in songs, prayer, feed your spirit with the word of God and inspirational books

Week 2: Confession: "to recognize" or "acknowledge." The acknowledging or confessing of faith (in God), and sins before God.

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23).

· Allow the Holy Spirit to search hearts for sin to be confessed and receive forgiveness.

Week 3: Thanksgiving: ("YDH"), in the Bible it means to respond to God's goodness and grace with gratitude. The word for giving thanks in the Old Testament means to raise hands to God in gratitude.

Father God, we thank you for:

- · Salvation, being filled with the Holy Spirit, our families.
- · Pastor, first family, our church family, and the body of Christ.
- · Prosperity, sound mind, healthy bodies, etc.

Week 4: Supplications: "to plead humbly." Father God, we ask for:

- · Your will to be done in the earth realm as it is in heaven.
- · Mercy, grace, wisdom, peace, increase our faith, deliverance, salvation for the lost, restoration for the downtrodden, committed believers, love, patience, power and anointing to witness and serve, oneness in the body of Christ, etc.
