The Weekly Prayer Focus

Prayer Points Psalm 133:1-3

1. Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity! 2. It is like the precious oil on the head, running down on the beard, on the beard of Aaron, running down on the collar of his robes! 3. It is like the dew of Hermon, which falls on the mountains of Zion! For there the Lord has commanded the blessing, life forevermore.

During these challenging times in our lives, our homes, cities, states, communities, and the world, Psalm 133 is a breath of fresh air, it's like water on parched ground and we all should heed to God's call to *"live together in unity."*

A little background of the psalm for us to meditate on: It's a song for going UP to A HIGH PLACE. To the Jews, that high place was the Temple in the city of Jerusalem. One literally "goes up" to Jerusalem. The city crowns the hill and its Temple stood on a "mount." In this exalted place, the highest act was to WORSHIP GOD! They sang Psalm 133 to express their joy in coming together for worship at the Temple, where God promised to meet them. It's said that this psalm is often used as a "Moto" for universities. And it's used during Easter because it's during this time, Christians seems to be united across the world. However, life's challenges should be even more reasons why we should come together, be unified in Christ and each other, and celebrating our 20th Year Church Anniversary is a great time to unite and be re-united in faith, hope and love!
