The Weekly Prayer Focus Points

Week 1: Kingdom Impact (through Trust. We trust God!) Father God, we make our boast in you and we ...

Thank You because You are the God of impossibilities. We believe you to begin a great deliverance that will turn around all captivity and put laughter into our mouth. Teach us how to walk by faith, to see difficulties in our life from Your perspective. Holy Spirit fire, begin to arrest the spirit of fear, doubt, unbelief, and unforgiveness in every area of our life

Today we bring before You this difficulty in our life (Name a hard situation you are right now facing). Help us not to fear but to trust You in this situation, to turn it around for our good and your glory.

We declare our faith in Your ability to fulfill and manifest Your promises. You will fight for us and win the battles in our life. Just like Joshua, You will give us the land and every place where our feet step

We trust our pastor's teaching, training, and godly examples and ask you to fill him the more with the Holy Spirit, bless him and his household, keep angels assigned to their lives and possessions in Jesus' name

Week 2: Kingdom Impact (through trials). Trials develop godly character, and it humbles us... Father God, we ask you to ...

Fill us again with the Holy Spirit and power who enables us to go through every test and trial with love in our heart

We repent of every door we have opened knowingly and unknowingly causing trials and tribulations. We receive your forgiveness, and we close every door that can hinder our prayers from being heard and answered. Use our bad decision, choices, hurts and shame to mold and shape us into your plans and purposes for our life so it brings you the ultimate glory and to us, good, in our homes; spiritual mothers who will fight in the spirit and do spiritual warfare, will teach the children, and pray for her husband We declare and decree that we are moved with compassion to do great exploits, Satan has no authority over us, our children, marriages, our businesses, ministry, and possessions, in Jesus' name. ~ Romans 5:3-5, 8; James 1:2-4, 12

Week 3: Kingdom Impact (Through Tests - to prove by trial). Let's remember that Satan's ability to try us is limited by Gods' sovereign control as with Job... Father God, we ask you to ...

Give us discernment to know when we are being tested by you. And the faith to go through as Abraham, who received the promised child, Isaac (who name means laughter),

Help us to see our testing as David; refined like silver, help us to pray more fervently and effectively with fasting, mature us, reveal us to ourselves, we desire Jesus' character demonstrated in all we do and speak Help us to be and say as Paul, I am crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me

Help us to submit to your testing and wait patiently for your directions as you prove us. Help us to die daily to ourselves and allow you to live the more in and through us, get glory out of our lives in Jesus' name ~ Matthews 26:39; Job 2:7; Psalm 66:10; Genesis 21:1-6; Galatians 2:20a

Week 4: Kingdom Impact (Through Temptation) An evil presentation to the mind sent by the devil. Father God, ...

We thank you for the power of the Holy Spirit in our life who prompts us to confess our sins, shortcomings, and ask for your forgiveness. To flee from every appearance of evil and ask for your mercy, break us of pride and of self and let the Holy Spirit fill us afresh. Every power of darkness that is competing with your power in our life, fighting against our spirituality, trying to destroy our testimonies, every contrary spirit moving around with us, we command them to be destroyed by the fire of the Holy Spirit. We bind prayerlessness, lack of proper study and meditation on the Word of God, and loose a hungry for the word and prayer, and to pray more in the spirit to build us up in our most holy faith. Every weapon of frustration targeted against us and our household to make us lose hope and faith in God, we command them to catch on fire, and we lose salvation to the lost and healing to the sick in Jesus' name. We nullify and destroy every activity of the murdering spirits, every destiny altering spirit upon our youth and premature death, be broken, and every satanic spirit speaking against the knowledge of God in our hearts and in our environment, we command them to be silenced forever in the name of Jesus. ~ 1 Thessalonians 5:17, 22; Joshua 1:8; Proverbs 3:5; Jude 1:20
