Prayer

As a little girl, I remember the older saints leading the congregation in a song with repeated lyrics that said, I will trust in the Lord, I will trust in the Lord, I will trust in the Lord until I die. The verses also spoke of treating everybody right as well as staying on the battlefield, and each verse ending with, until I die. The smile on their faces and the firmness in their voices made me feel as though they meant every word.

Trust by definition is a firm belief in the reliability, truth, ability, or strength of someone or something. In the Bible "trust" literally means 'a bold, confident, sure security or action based on that security.' Trust is also believing in the promises of God in all circumstances even in those where the evidence seems to be to the contrary.

Proverbs 3:5-6 says,
