Classroom Placement Policy Many factors, including age, child readiness, and carefully balanced classes are considered when determining classroom placement for children. In order to achieve the best classroom environment and placement for each child, class placement is determined by St. John's Children's Center.

Financial Policies

1. The non-refundable registration fee is required when the child is accepted into the school.
2. Families enter into an admission agreement with the school at the time of enrollment. No monthly statement will be sent. Receipts will be emailed upon request.
3. Full tuition is due by the first (1st) of the month, prior to the child's attendance. Delinquent tuition payments will be assessed a \$15.00 late charge after the 5th with an additional \$1.00 per day added after the 5th. Delinquent payments of 15 days, or repetitive delinquent monthly payments, without prior approval of the administrative staff, may result in the suspension of enrolled child(ren).
4. The tuition is computed on a ten month basis and then divided into monthly payments. All school scheduled days off (see calendar of holidays) have been figured into the yearly fee. Tuition is based on the actual costs of operating the center divided by the number of children enrolled in a variety of programs.
5. Refunds: There are no make-up days or refunds given for holidays or absences. While it is intended that these terms and fees remain unchanged during a full school year, St. John's Children's Center, with the approval of the Board of Directors, may amend these terms or fees with written notice to parents of enrolled children up to 30 days prior to the increase.

Labor Day, Thanksgiving week, Christmas/winter break (including Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day), Martin Luther King Jr's Birthday, Veterans Day, President's Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Memorial Day, Independence Day.

***The Children's Center will be closed from **July 26-August 6, 2021** for building maintenance and staff training. We also closed three days throughout the school year to allow for professional development days for our staff. All days closed will be reflected on our **annual calendar**.

Security Practices:

All doors to the Children's Center are kept locked at all times. Therefore, any person bringing or picking up their child(ren) will need to obtain a "fob" to unlock the doors. The first two fobs are covered by registration fees. Additional fobs cost \$10 each which includes the cost of the fob and the monthly service rate. These may be purchased at the front desk by parents only, who can then assign them to family members .
