### **Peace & Global Witness**

A gift to the Peace & Global Witness Offering enables the church to promote the Peace of Christ by addressing systems of conflict and injustice across the world. Individual congregations are encouraged to utilize up to 25% of this Offering to connect with the global witness of Christ's peace. Mid councils retain an additional 25% for ministries of peace and reconciliation. The remaining 50% is used by the Presbyterian Mission Agency to advocate for peace and justice in cultures of violence, including our own, through collaborative projects of education and Christian witness. This offering will be received on World Communion Sunday, October 3.

## **All Saints Day**

All Saints Day this year will be observed on **October 31.** We will remember with great fondness and respect our church members who have died this past year. There will be an opportunity for family members to come forward to the chancel area to light a candle in remembrance of loved ones. # **PNC Update**

The Pastor Nominating Committee wants to provide occasional updates to reassure you that the search for our next Pastor/Head of Staff is active and ongoing. We began our work 11 months ago now by creating a 14-page Ministry Information Form, which was submitted to the Church Leadership Connection, the internet-based matching and referral system of the Presbyterian Church (USA). We also published ads in The Presbyterian Outlook.

To date we have:

- Reviewed Pastor Information Forms, viewed sermons, and discussed 43 matched candidates.
- Spent many hours individually reviewing candidates, and we've held 20 meetings—typically 2-hour ZOOM meetings—discussing our findings.
- Conducted interviews with 3 candidates and second interviews with 2 candidates.
- Committed to prayerfully seeking the person God is calling to serve our church.

The PNC consists of 9 members with a variety of skills and perspectives. The group works very well together—sometimes in full agreement and sometimes respectfully disagreeing. All of us are confident that our work is effective and will bear fruit in good time. We appreciate your patience and your ongoing prayers.
