

## Urgent Text Notifications

**Text notifications would be limited to items needing urgent attention.** These texts would be limited to the following:

- **Baptisms:** Message sent for baptisms:
  - Example: We rejoice in the baptism of Clint Montgomery today, June 5 <https://clearcreekcoc.org/daily-news>
- **Prayer Requests:** Urgent, sudden or emergency requests needing immediate prayer within 48 hours
  - Example: Prayer Request: John Doe's son, Jack Doe, is having surgery tomorrow. Details at <https://clearcreekcoc.org/daily-news>
  - Example: Prayer Request: John Doe, father of Jane Doe, was in a car accident and has multiple injuries. Details at <https://clearcreekcoc.org/daily-news>
- **Death notifications:** Members and their parents, children, and siblings
  - Example: We express sympathy to John Doe and family on the death of his mother, Janice Doe. Details at <https://clearcreekcoc.org/daily-news>
- **Weather notifications:** Text when a major church service or activity will be cancelled due to weather
  - Example: In person worship will be cancelled for Sunday, Jan. 16, due to weather advisory.

- Click the link **Prayer Notifications** and complete the form to automatically be added to the Prayer Notifications list. The form consists of blanks for name, phone, and email address.
  - Example: If you wish to sign up to receive urgent text notifications needing immediate attention, such as prayer requests or deaths, or for weather cancellations, please complete the form at [Prayer Notifications](#) to sign up.

**We must be given specific permission by the individual or an immediate family member** to make the information public and to be published online.

- Public prayer requests and death notifications would go through the text notifications system and would no longer be emailed to the elders and ministers since they will be receiving a text.
- Private prayers requests would continue to be emailed to the elders and ministers only.

**\*Subscribe Comment:** Texting without consent is against the law. Subscribing on our website would comply with this requirement.
