

Part Five: "I Am Thirsty"

¬TEACHING NOTES ⊢

A. John 19:28-29, Later, knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, "I am thirsty." 29 A jar of wine vinegar was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant, and lifted it to Jesus' lips.

B. Jesus' 5th Saying tells us:
1. We're all thirsty for
o (John 4) The woman at the well was physically, relationally, and spiritually thirsty.
2. The world is good at distracting us from what
 John 4:13-14, "<u>Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again</u>, but whoever drinks the <u>water I give them will never thirst</u>. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life."
3. What does Jesus for?
 John 19:28,knowing that <u>everything had now been finished</u>, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled
 Matthew 5:6, "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled."
"Righteous" is doing God's will God's way.
Answer: Jesus thirsts for God's to be done God's
Question: What do you thirst for in this moment? (Prayer Time)

- Adoration: Praise God for who he is. ("I praise you God because you are...")
- o Gratitude: Thank God for what he has done. ("I thank you God because you have...")
- o Confidence: Ask God for what you / others need. ("Give us today our daily bread.")
- o Confession: Let go of your sins. ("This is what I have done. I receive your forgiveness.")
- Listen: Ask what Jesus wants from you in the coming days.
