

## Part Five: "I Am Thirsty"

April 10, 2022

### —TEACHING NOTES—

A. John 19:28-29, *Later, knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, "I am thirsty." 29 A jar of wine vinegar was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant, and lifted it to Jesus' lips.*

B. Jesus' 5th Saying tells us:

1. We're all thirsty for \_\_\_\_\_.

- (John 4) The woman at the well was physically, relationally, and spiritually thirsty.

2. The world is good at distracting us from what \_\_\_\_\_.

- John 4:13-14, *"Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life."*

3. What does Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ for?

- John 19:28, *...knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled...*
- Matthew 5:6, *"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled."*
- "Righteous" is doing God's will God's way.
- Answer: Jesus thirsts for God's \_\_\_\_\_ to be done God's \_\_\_\_\_.

Question: What do you thirst for in this moment? (Prayer Time)

- Adoration: Praise God for who he is. ("I praise you God because you are...")
- Gratitude: Thank God for what he has done. ("I thank you God because you have...")
- Confidence: Ask God for what you / others need. ("Give us today our daily bread.")
- Confession: Let go of your sins. ("This is what I have done. I receive your forgiveness.")
- Listen: Ask what Jesus wants from you in the coming days.
