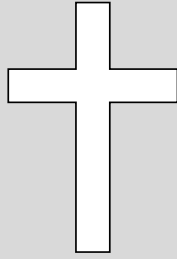

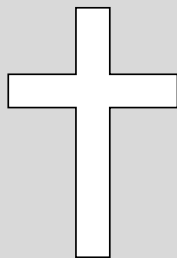

The Cost of Forgiveness (Matthew 18:21-35)

- 1 Day's wage = 1 Denarii (Silver Coin) | 6,000 Denarii = 1 Talent | 10,000 Talents = 60 Million Days
- The King: Bears the cost and dies to the bookkeeping system, so that his servant may have life.
- The Servant: Unlike the king, he clings to the book-keeping system.
- We are either in the book-keeping system or not.
