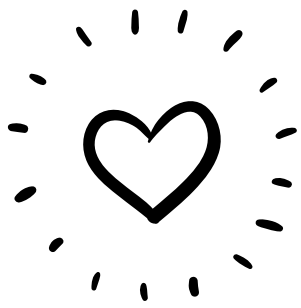
#### B. THE THREE 'LOVES' OF HEBREW
