ACTS 11:24 (NIV), He [Barnabas] was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and faith, and a great number of people were brought to the Lord.

- Acts 4:36 Levite, Cyprus, Nickname, Gave Money to the needy Church
- Acts 9:27 Vouched for Saul w/ fearful Jerusalem Church
- Acts 11:19-30 Went to Antioch, Took Paul, Carried \$ to Judean Christians
- Acts 12:25 Back to Antioch with Paul & John Mark
- Acts 13-14 Joined Paul's 1st Missionary journey with John Mark
- Acts 15:1-35 Major part of Jerusalem Counsel (circumcision). Brought verdict to Gentiles
- Acts 15:36-40 Broke from Paul over John Mark. Took John Mark on future trips.


