God's Math

When I hold a tennis racket, it's just a tennis racket. But put that racket in the hands of Serena Williams and it becomes the instrument of 39 grand slam titles, seven-time Wimbledon champion, six-time US Open champion, three-time French Open champion and the seven-time Australian Open champion.

When I hold a football, it's just a football. But put that ball in the hands of Tom Brady and it becomes the instrument for seven Super Bowl Championships, four Super Bowl MVPs, three NFL Most Valuable Player awards, 14 Pro Bowls, numerous records...plus one super model wife.

When I hold a pen, it's just a pen. But put it in the hands of Danielle Steel and you end up with 179 books, 146 novels, and over 800 million copies sold.

When I hold a basketball, it's just a basketball. But if you put that ball in the hands of Lebron James, it multiplies into two NBA Championships, four league MVPs, and two Olympic gold medals.

A paintbrush and a chisel in my hand is still just a paintbrush and a chisel. But put them into the hands of Michelangelo and you get the priceless ceiling of the Sistine Chapel and the statue of David.

How is it that the same things can bring about such dramatically different results simply by putting them into the right hands? It all comes down to who is holding them.

2,000 years ago, a young boy puts his lunch into Jesus' hands and kaboom, something miraculous was about to happen. 5,000 people fed with one small lunch from one small boy. Wow!


All this brings us to the Harvest of Talents. People making and bringing a small gift to be sold. Whatever your contribution is, compared to the number of starving people in the world, what is such a small contribution among such a big need?

Truth? We didn't give it to the church, and we didn't give it to Harvest of Talents, we gave it to Jesus.

Have you noticed that our government can give billions of dollars away to underprivileged countries and it doesn't even make a dent in their suffering? But we can give a few thousand to a missionary and before long they'll build a church, a school and a hospital, have fresh water wells dug, and teach farming techniques, and the list goes on and on. How can we explain that?

Jesus...period! During the Harvest this year, you just give your best gift. And then watch! The real miracle comes after the Harvest and what Jesus will do to multiply it.

Global Impact



TCM

The full name for TCM is TCM International Institute. When TCM was founded in 1957, it was "Toronto Christian Mission," a church-planting organization in Toronto, Canada. Gene Dulin was the founder and the headquarters were based in Toronto. While there, Mr. Dulin met many Christians from Eastern Europe and learned of the needs of Christians behind the Iron Curtain and felt led to minister to those people. Consequently, he began to make trips to Eastern Europe, and the need there was so great, the mission of Toronto Christian Mission was expanded to serve Christians in Eastern and Central Europe. In 1971, Haus Edelweiss was purchased in Austria to serve as a base of operations in Europe from which trips were made behind the Iron Curtain to serve the Christians there and to provide benevolent assistance to them. The headquarters of the mission was moved to Indianapolis in 1975 and the name was officially changed to TCM International. At that time, the slogan, "Taking Christ to the Millions" was used, but TCM was not an acronym at that time.

Then after the fall of the Iron Curtain, and it was easier to travel to the Communist countries, the Christians there were asked what their greatest need was, and their answer was "leadership training." So once again the focus of the mission of TCM was changed to provide leadership training and benevolent assistance to the Christians of Eastern and Central Europe. Thus, TCM International Institute was established to provide training for Christian leaders in Europe, and currently in Central Asia. Later the official name of the organization was changed to TCM International Institute, with the mission being to develop Christian leaders to serve in their own countries and cultures. The *slogan* used was changed to "Training Christians for Ministry," but again this was a slogan and *not* the meaning of an acronym.

Currently both slogans are used — "Taking Christ to the Millions by Training Christians for Ministry." *However*, TCM is not an actual acronym with the letters standing for anything specific. TCM was well established when the focus of the mission changed, and was recognized by the official three letters "TCM" so the official name was changed to "TCM International" and then "TCM International Institute," and just referred to as TCM.

TCM's ministry provides a response to Jesus' command to make disciples of all nations. Their vision statement is that every nation will have effective leaders of disciple-making movements, impacting their churches, cultures, and countries for Christ.

With almost 2,000 students and graduates in nearly 50 nations in Europe, Central Asia, the Middle East, Africa, and the United States, TCM students and graduates are national Christian leaders actively focusing on becoming better equipped to serve in their ministries and to be better disciple makers.

Since 1991 TCM's mission has focused on equipping nationals to reach their own people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Throughout the last two years TCM continued to grow and expand its mission of Developing Christian leaders for significant service through higher learning. This is illustrated through:

- Forty-six students completed the requirements for their TCM diplomas in 2020 and dozens more in 2021.
- 50 students from Kenya are well on their way to achieving their Master of Arts degrees from TCM – fully delivered in Nairobi, Kenya.
- TCM's program in the United States continues to grow alongside our program in Europe, Asia, and Africa. American students serving in vocational and bi-vocational ministry are admitted to the program three times a year in Indianapolis and Arizona.

TCM's academic classes are delivered through a "Hybrid Model." This Hybrid Model includes 80% of each course being completed through distance education. The remaining 20% delivered in person at what we call "Mentoring Retreats" where the course professor, such as Fred Hansen, and the students meet face to face at either Haus Edelweiss or at one of TCM's 26 other Mentoring Centers.

Due to the Covid pandemic, many of the mentoring retreats in 2020 and 2021 have needed to be converted to 100% online due to the travel restrictions imposed. Thankfully, because of TCM's experience with distance delivery not one class has been canceled due to the pandemic! Since the start of the pandemic, some of the mentoring centers have been able to meet face-to-face. We continue to monitor the health/safety situation for each country we work in and remain flexible yet committed to completing the needed ministry training courses in the most effective way possible.

TCM is grateful to Lincoln Christian Church for your ongoing prayer and financial support of TCM's efforts to further develop disciples who make disciples, thank you!
