

In spite of isolation, bribes, corruption, government restrictions, and lack of medical resources, the churches in Kerala state are thriving by being the hands and feet of Jesus during the pandemic. There have been few Covid deaths in these churches due to the care of the Christians.

The mature churches started by Matthew Veraguese many decades ago have matured and are working alongside smaller and start-up churches. Many are becoming human ambulances to take Covid patients to hospitals and field centers. People are scared to live in their homes and are camping around the churches with Christian teens protecting their vacant properties in contrast to the Hindu leaders who forbid their camping out on their property. Domestic violence has decreased because alcohol is forbidden to those camping on the church property. Hindu parents are allowing their young children to hear Bible stories and to receive missed schooling with some parents learning to read and write along with their children who, in turn, are teaching other children Bible stories and choruses. James and Valsamma Abraham, on-the-field directors, are studying crisis counseling courses to help those struggling with domestic issues resulting from Covid.

As a minority in Hindu India, the churches are becoming confident leaders in the communities, in faith, trust, and obedience to the living Word.

Please continue to pray for these churches to reach the Hindus and Muslims around them. Praise God for his marvelous works in India as these Christians continue as the hands and feet of Christ.

The goal was to shift nursing home care from the strictly physical to include the spiritual as well. Stepping out in faith, these men acquired land and raised funds to make this dream a reality.
