Top Heavy?

In the early 1600s, the war was raging across Europe and the King of Sweden knew he needed a strong naval presence in the Baltic. He commissioned the Vasa ship to be built with two gun decks, 64 bronze cannons and a crew of 450 men. She would be the pride of the sea.

On August 10, 1628, the ship set sail on its maiden voyage, but only barely offshore. As everyone watched, disaster struck, and the ship keeled over and sank with the loss of about 150 men.

What happened? How could a new ship just off shore already sink without seeing one full day at sea or fighting in a single battle? Sabotage? Hidden reef? For many years, there were no answers.

Then, in 1962, the ship was salvaged and brought to the surface. The intricately beautiful carvings and miraculous state of preservation were a wonder to behold. However, it was clear that the reason the ship sank was from a fatal flaw in its design. It was so top heavy that even a light breeze would have pushed her over.


You can see the ship today. It's on display in its own museum in central Stockholm. Images are stunning. She is still a major attraction but not for her service in battle or for her sea travels, but as an illustration of building flaws and failed life.

The lessons are many I'm sure, but the first one that jumps out to me is beware of building a life that is too top heavy with nothing of substance below the water line. It's important: who we are deep down inside, who we will be in our core, what holds us grounded when storms come. That's more important than the ornate decorations everybody can easily see.

Jesus said, "Good people do good things because of the good in their hearts, but bad people do bad things because of the evil in their hearts. Your words show what is in your heart." ~ Luke 6:45

Who we are deep inside comes out in our actions and words. Who we are deep down comes out when we face storms. Be careful to give attention to not only the outside, but make sure we are people of value, character, and substance deep down below.

You will greet people entering the building or a worship service about one Sunday per month or whenever you're available to sign up



community. PBT and members of the deaf community are working together to translate the Action Bible into sign language for the deaf in Poland! In Ukraine, God used Jan to minister to Roma (Gypsy) people by bringing them Christmas gifts and sharing the love of Christ. PBT is involved in translation work with the Roma people as well. Pioneer Bible Translators is celebrating its 46th year, and Rondal and Janice Smith have begun their 41st year of serving the Lord through PBT. Our congregation has been a partner in this work nearly as long! When they began, PBT had 23 persons serving in six projects. The Smiths are thankful for

God's faithfulness: PBT now has a team of 593 adults (and 280 children) working in 28 countries in 108 languages that impact 102.5 million people! PBT's goal is to reach every Bibleless and churchless ethnic group, so please join the Smiths in praying that God's Word may become available in more languages through another 200 projects by the year 2050. 167 million people are without access to Scripture in their mother tongue (2,014 languages, including 400 sign languages). Rondal and Jan help organize and mobilize believers and churches here and in Europe to recruit, train, send and care for workers for the PBT field teams in translation and disciple making movements.
