What Faith Looks Like

Like you, my prayers are not always answered the way I want. I don't always understand what God is doing. If I'm honest when I'm asked "What do you gain in prayer?" My answer is "Little." Then why pray? Because it's not always about what I gain but what I lose: anger, ego, insecurity, and fear of dying. So I just keep praying!

Joshua and Israel found themselves facing a great fortified city of Jericho. Jericho was the last city between them and their promise land. God said, "I want you to march once a day for seven days around the walls." So, day after day, in the hot sun, in the dust, they're thirsty, worn out, and tempted to quit, but they did it.

Wouldn't it be nice to see a crack in the wall or two? Wouldn't it have been nice to hear a little thunder? Nope! Nothing! But day after day they marched. "Just show us a sign, God, come on!" Still...nothing! No rumbles. No shakings! No fractures in walls!!

Now it's the seventh day and God came again and asked them to march around seven more times without seeing the walls weakening. They again did it. Once finished, they lifted up a loud shout, and the walls came tumbling down.

Could we do that? Keep marching without seeing any signs of our faith working? Could we keep believing without seeing a miracle or God's mighty hand at work? Could we keep singing in the dark? That's what Paul and Silas did in Acts 16:25.

About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God from their unjust prison cell. Other prisoners were listening. They were singing in the dark. Before they could see God move, before the miracle prison break, before they knew what God was up to, they were still singing and praising him. And other prisoners were spellbound.

Again, does that sound like us? Are we going to walk away from God, away from the church, away from our faith just because we don't see any signs of it working? Are we going to give up on God because we may be in a season of silence?

Or do we keep marching? Today I think I will march forward. Today I will sing in the darkness.

Who's with me?!

1) Sign up to lead a group of 3-5 friends to discuss our fall series "Running on Empty." We provide you discussion questions and a coach to help! Or...





GLOBAL IMPACT

Asia Pacific International (API)



Lincoln Christian Church has supported this mission in Indonesia since the beginning with Chuck and Nance Winegarner in the 1970s. Gi and Mei Tanbunnan, the next directors, are the most familiar to LCC. Mei learned to quilt from the quilters here and took these skills back to Indonesia only to find that at least one of the women knew a Korean method of sitting on the floor with the quilt. Several women sit on different parts of the quilt at the same time. Mei is responsible for the beautiful and one-of-a-kind quilts auctioned at the Harvest of Talents. Icah Herlina is the current director, but Gi and Mei are still involved in the leadership along with their daughter Leila.

Indonesia consists of 17,508 islands with most of the people living on the five largest islands. The mission headquarters is located on Central Java. Church planters are serving in 28 of the 36 provinces. Much outreach must be done indirectly since Islam strongly opposes Christian evangelism. Persecution does exist—church buildings have been burned and church pastors beaten. But evangelism doesn't stop!

Here are some of the indirect approaches to outreach in use. Church planters are taught skills that can help the people in their area such as cutting hair, acupuncture, sewing, baking to earn money to help their families. Smart Point is an educational program for preschool children to prepare them for kindergarten. Mothers who bring the children are also taught skills, even in the use of a computer. A prison ministry exists to help released inmates on parole. Bible correspondence courses are available for people to study the Bible in the privacy of their homes. A free medical clinic exists in the area of the mission headquarters; it became a mobile unit during a time of persecution at the mission.

Baptisms are reported weekly—some done in secret to avoid persecution. Daniel, a former boxer, has served in Bali, which is Hindu, for decades. He reported 11 baptisms on Easter. Prayer requests include healing for a church planter from a motorcycle accident. Motorcycles (not the very large ones) are the only affordable vehicle for them on which a family of five rides. Pray for their safety as traffic is crazy. Several church planters are praying


for building funds of \$350 or \$900 to buy land for a building. One asks for a guitar for worship.

The giving to API from LCC is well spent. Islam is growing faster than Christianity. Islam claims to be the only true religion, and it is a serious threat to the church. Pray for safety, wisdom and courage for our brothers and sisters in Indonesia.
