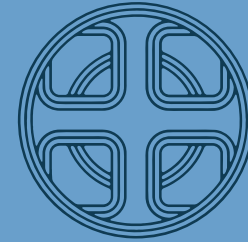
## PPC Visitor Luncheon • Sunday, March 27<sup>th</sup>
