Philadelphia Conference on Reformed Theology • April 29 - May 1

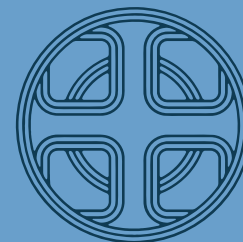
