College and Grad Student Luncheon • October 3

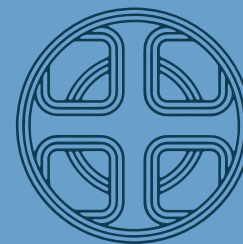
