

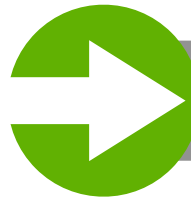


## Harvest

*A missionary engages the lost & unchurched, plants the gospel, and makes disciple-making disciples. They raise up leaders to lead the groups of disciples that develop.*

### Key Features and Highlights

- You take the gospel to people and meet people where they are in their context.
- You look for and raise up leaders from among those you are trying to reach.
- You won't lead the microchurches that emerge.
- You stay connected to the sending microchurch.
- You can do this on your own, or with help.



## Be Sent Out

*A leader is sent out from an existing microchurch to start a new one. They are sent with a small plant team consisting of people from their sending microchurch, pod, or hub.*

### Key Features and Highlights

- You go out to create a new microchurch context that you will invite people to.
- You leave your sending microchurch once the new one is established.
- You lead the new microchurch.
- You are sent out with a small group of people from your microchurch, pod, or hub to establish culture in your new microchurch.



## Yo-Yo Plant

*A leader, or leaders plant a new microchurch without ever leaving their sending microchurch. They raise up leaders, help establish culture, and eventually leave the new microchurch.*

### Key Features and Highlights

- You go out to create a new microchurch context where you may invite people.
- You raise up a new leader for the microchurch.
- You stay connected to the sending microchurch.
- You along with some others are sent out to help kickstart culture in a new community.
- After establishing culture and critical mass, you leave the new microchurch.



## Group Split

*A leader takes on an apprentice who will learn how to lead the microchurch. When the microchurch reaches a certain size or when the apprentice is ready the one group will split into two or more.*

### Key Features and Highlights

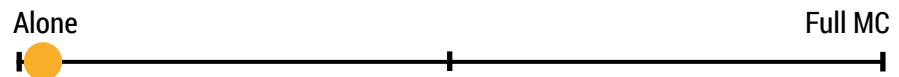
- You maintain the group's established culture and create more spaces to invite people into.
- Future leaders are apprentices from within the microchurch.
- You stay connected to a portion of your original community and you leave a portion as well.
- Each leader maintains connection to a complete and established microchurch.



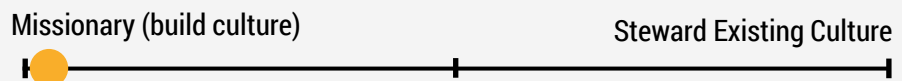

*A leader is sent out from an existing microchurch to start a new one. They are sent with a small plant team consisting of people from their sending microchurch, pod, or hub.*

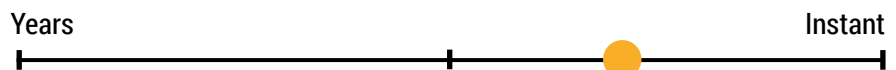

*A leader, or leaders plant a new microchurch without ever leaving their sending microchurch. They raise up leaders, help establish culture, and eventually leave the new microchurch.*

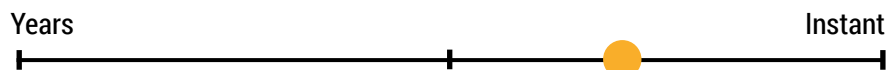

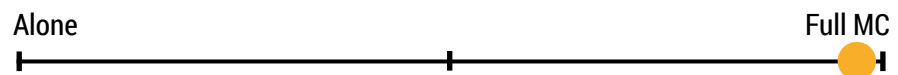




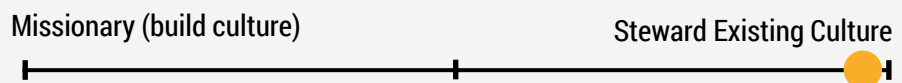
# Group Split
