General Summary:

The Videographer should be an experienced creative storyteller that uses vision, aesthetics, composition, and editing to passionately tell God's stories in an innovative and compelling way. This person will develop, shoot, and edit videos, working collaboratively alongside pastors and ministry leaders. The ideal candidate will not just capture moments or create "stuff" but will be a fountain of development ideas, helping leaders to actualize their vision. Above all else, they must help maintain, promote, and convey the mission of the County Line Church of God.

Skills/Abilities Required:

- Recognize Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
- Have high interpersonal skills toward staff, congregational members, and people outside the church.
- Has the ability to communicate well verbally and through written means.
- Good understanding of videography and editing.
- High integrity and full buy-in to the County Line Church of God mission and vision.
- Able to recruit, train, and develop volunteers towards a common goal.
- Able to organize, coordinate, and execute projects within a specified period.
- Is teachable and willing to ask questions.
- Good organizational skills to honor timelines of others when scheduling and filming videos.
- Ability to work in a high capacity environment to produce videos weekly, monthly, and yearly.

Responsibilities:

- Assist all ministries by creating videos based on the vision of the teams assigned to the projects. Creative input from the Videographer is encouraged. However, the pastor or director overseeing the project has the final say in any negotiable areas.
- Actively seek and produce high-quality and impactful testimonial videos. These videos would be used within the Thursday and Sunday service and on social

media and other outlets. The Videographer will have a passion for sharing stories of life change.

- Work closely with the Technical Arts Director to ensure Thursday and Sunday morning elements flow smoothly.
- Assist the Technical Arts Director with any video camera needs on Thursday Evenings and Sunday mornings.
- Attend the weekly Creative Team meetings. This is where most video ideas for our Sunday morning services will come from.
- Film the weekly spotlight and produce “The Things You Need To Know” segment.
- Film and produce ministry videos as needed, such as ministry highlights, sermon bumpers, and special service videos such as Souper Bowl, Faith In Action, etc.
- Mentor youth within County Line who are interested in videography by including them in projects.

Educational and Background Preferences:

Formal training in film production or communications is preferred—at least three or more years of experience in visual arts production. Willingness to continually pursue training that will increase knowledge in videography and photography.
