

**The Reverend Carol Record Scholarship
Sponsored by the Unity Church of Northeast Tarrant County
also known as the Center of Unity, Grapevine, Texas
2020-2021**

As part of our service to our community and responsibility to support education, each year, the Center of Unity in Grapevine awards scholarships to graduating seniors from Grapevine High School, Colleyville Heritage High School, and Center of Unity. This program awards the maximum of a \$2,000 one-time scholarship to each candidate chosen by our scholarship committee. The scholarship payment will be sent directly to the student's chosen educational institution as a deposit on the student's account.

The Reverend Carol Record Scholarship Committee awards scholarships based on financial need, academic performance/potential, community service, leadership, and personal goals/spirituality. Below you will find a list of requirements and guidelines. **Failure to adhere to the guidelines or furnish the required application components will render the submitted Application disqualified.**

Criteria for Eligibility

- Applicants must be high school seniors who are applying to colleges, universities or vocational/technical institutions.
- Applicants must be graduating seniors from Grapevine High School, Colleyville Heritage High School or those who attend the Center of Unity in Grapevine, Texas. **The Center of Unity seniors are eligible to apply; however, there is no guarantee of receiving a Rev. Carol Record Scholarship.** Applicants must have a current cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher based upon a 4.0 GPA Scale.

Application Components and Procedures:

- Complete application form. **All questions MUST be answered. Do remember that the application must provide an accurate narrative of you and your accomplishments. Be sure all information is legible.**
- Must include full address including zip code

- Must include total family size
- Must include your scholarship/grant information
- Must be completed and mailed by **MIDNIGHT, FEBRUARY 14, 2021.**
- **TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:** One recommendation from a teacher or school administrator and another from a community leader, work supervisor, minister, spiritual leader, etc. **with signatures.**
- **The scholarship committee will review the submitted applications and select applicants for interviewing.** Students selected will be notified by phone or e-mail with an appointment date and time.
- Applicant interview process
- Scholarship committee selects recipients.
- Notification will be sent via e-mail to the recipients by **April 19, 2021.**
