“For God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son. God gave his Son so that whoever believes in him may not be lost, but have eternal life.”



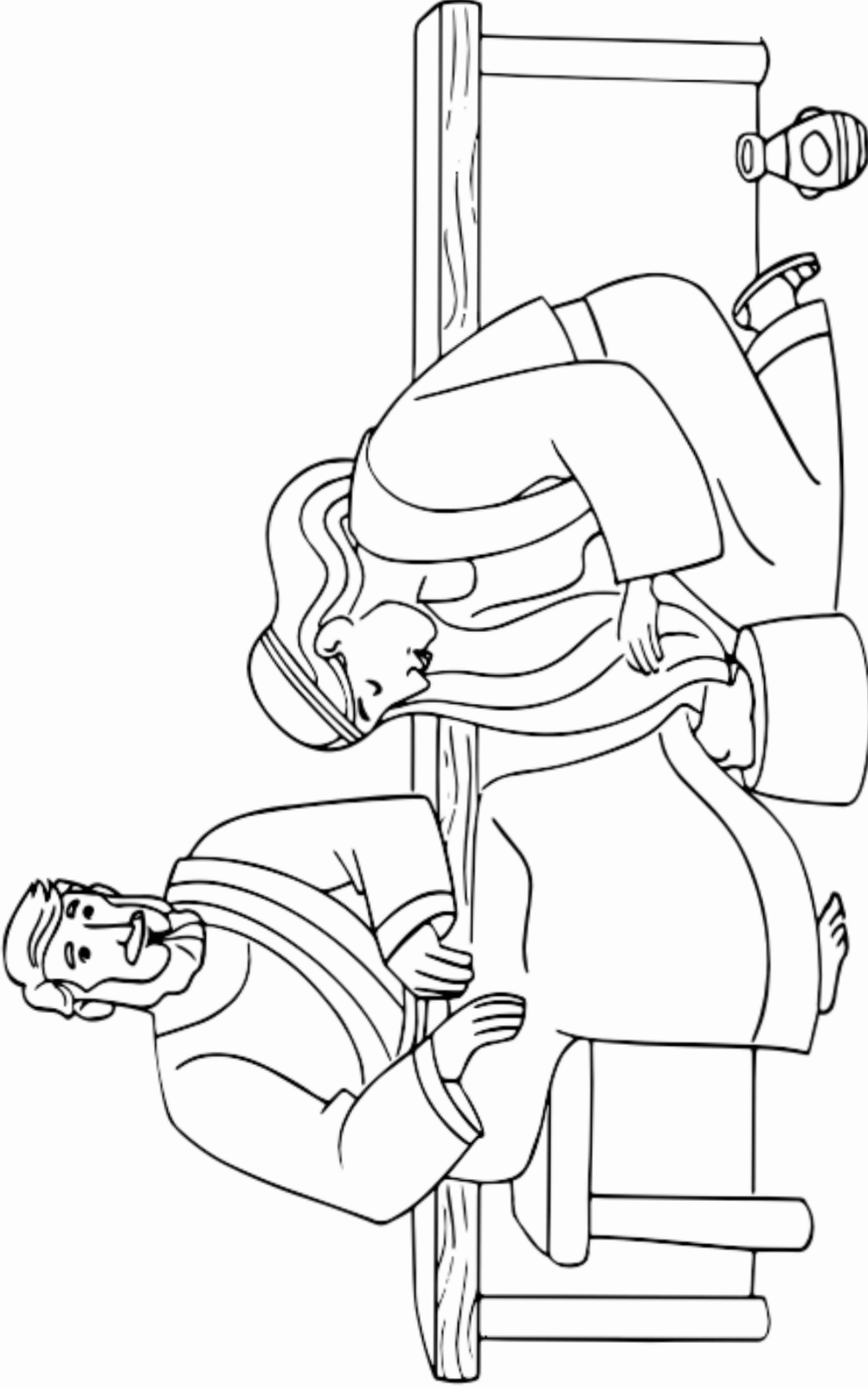
Bible Study

Mary probably didn't understand all that was happening that week, but she wanted to express her love for Jesus. We may lack understanding as well, but we can show our love for Him just as she did.

Main Point: Giving your best to Jesus!

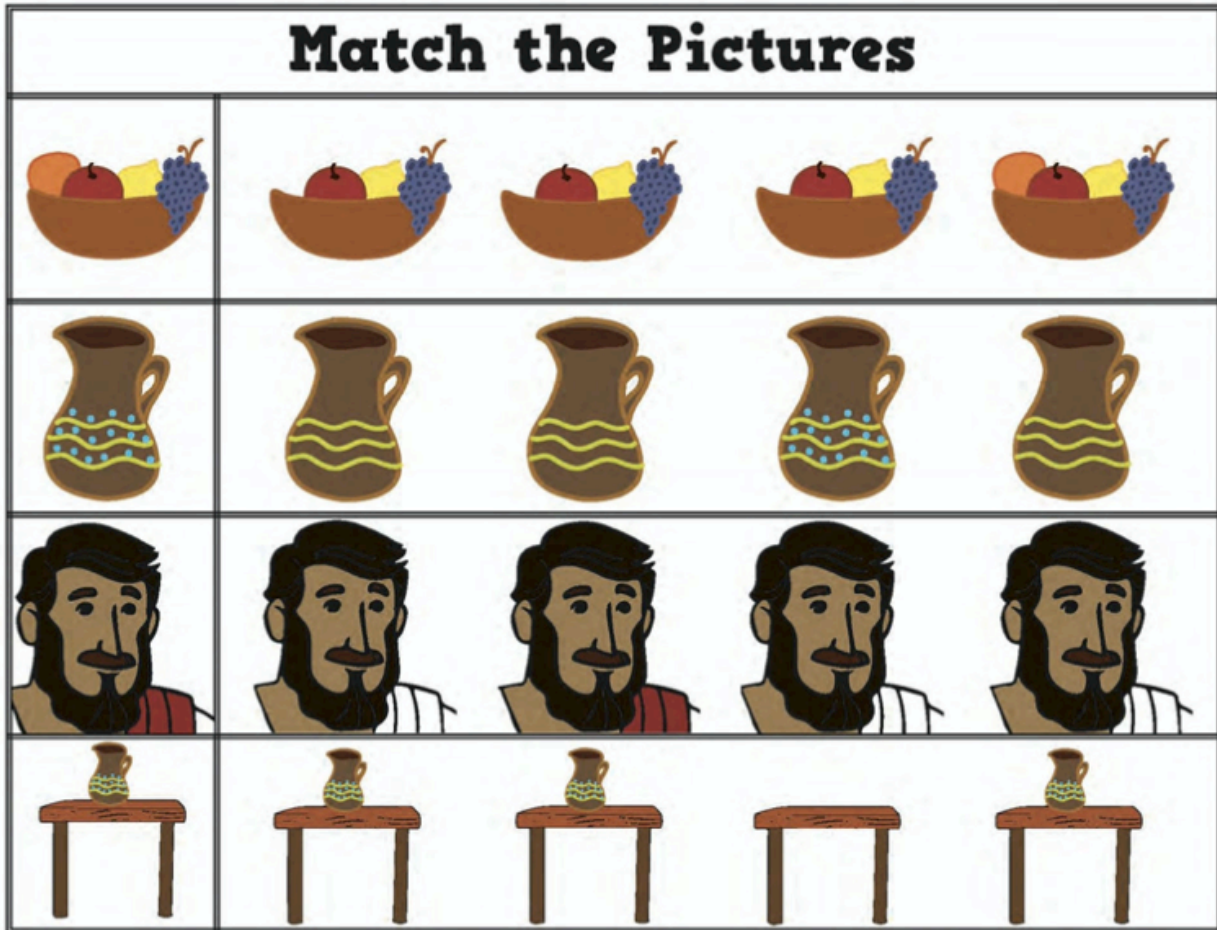
Prayer: Thank you God for being our Friend and helping us show our love to You and to others. In Jesus Name. Amen

Game Time/Dismissal

Fruit Basket Turnover

Supplies:

- No supplies needed

What to Do: Ask children to stand in a circle. Give each child a name of fruit to remember. Use no more than three different fruit names. To play, call out a name of a fruit and the children with that fruit name have to switch places. Call out all the fruit names one time, then say, "Fruit basket turn over!" When this is called, everyone switches places.

Remind boys and girls of our Bible Phrase, "Jesus said, 'You are my friends'" (John 15:14). Express that one way to show our love to Jesus is by being kind to others.
