What is Shema?

For thousands of years, Jewish people have daily prayed the "Shema" or other known as Deuteronomy 6:4-5. It's a prayer that calls God's people to respond to the divine love with faithfulness and devotion. The next 6 weeks will explore the Hebrew words contained in the "Shema" to better explain its overall theme.

Family Discussion
