- The wood was cover in bronze which means judgement our sin.
- The Altar was lit by God's fire and was to kept burning day and night, never to die out which means God is always ready to accept us when we look for forgiveness.
- The altar had 4 horns which means the corners of the earth Isaiah 45:22 which means Jesus salvation is fo everyone.
- The altar of sacrifice was a picture of Jesus sacrifice on the cross of Calvary Hebrew 9:26

DISCUSSION

- Once we have entered, we will have have to move down to the first stop on the way in. The bronze altar of sacrifice, where they sacrificed animals to God.
