



## WEEK 5 - Golden Lamp Stand - Menorah

**John 8:12** *Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."*

- The lamp stand was filled with oil every morning and night because it had to burn and never run out. The same way Jesus will be there for us day or night.

Now let's read this scripture from **Psalms 119:105** "Your word is like a lamp for my feet and a light for my way"

### DISCUSSION:
