THE ZONE

Week 5: Moses

Virtue: Your Love Makes Me Brave !

Memory Verse: Ephesians 3:20 “with Gods power working in us, God can do much more”



INTERACT: The lord spoke to Moses, to lift his staff and stretch his hand out over the sea. God split and opened the red sea for the Israelites so that they can cross over. Moses had faith in God and he listened to him. The people of Israel walked through the middle of the sea with walls of water on each side. God can do miraculous things to your life today if you have faith in him. You just have to have faith like Moses.

BOTTOM LINE: Just like Moses I can be brave even if I feel fearful.

PRAY: Dear God thank you for always making a way for us. Thank you for your protection in Jesus Name. Amen.



PLAY: What is faith game.

WHAT YOU NEED: (a pillowcase of random small items brought from home- 10-15 items)

Have kids reach in one at a time, feel around in the bag and remember one thing that they felt in the bag. Once all kids named things they were certain were in the bag, pull them out of the bag and show them. Ask questions like... right, there was a toothbrush, but did you know it was yellow? See how many of the items in the bag the kids is able to identify.

SAY: "You seemed fairly certain of what was in the pillowcase even though you couldn't see inside.

You see that is what Faith means, it is things we hope for and trust God for even if can't see it or know what will happen. Hebrew 11:1

CRAFT: Red Sea

What you will need: Paper plate; paint; markers; craft glue; sand (alternative to sand crumble a biscuit or cereal) and ocean creature stickers optional.
