Week 2 - Bible Story of Moses in the Tent

Memory Verse: Philippians 4:6

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything.

Tell God what you need, and thank Him for all He has done.





Theme: Moses in the Tent

Explain to your child that prayer is talking to God. Read 1 Corinthians 3:16 and explain that we no longer need to build God a tent since He lives in our hearts. Remind kids we can make out hearts God's dwelling place by asking His forgiveness and believing that Jesus died to save us.

Main Point: I can be best friends with the GOD when I pray!

Prayer: Thank you God for dwelling with us. Help us use our gifts that you gave us to serve You. In Jesus Name. Amen




TENT STORY AND PRAY TIME
