Here are 3 ways to worship with a heart like David's:

## 1) David's psalms that he wrote shows how much he wanted to know God.

We can so much to learn from David about how He was so focused on God and was always wanting to be closer to God. The same God who created the beautiful earth and beauty around us is the same God who spoke the Word and still speaks it into our lives. Those are all reasons to worship Him.

#### 2) David learned to worship God in any situation.

David wrote Psalm 63 when he was in the wilderness of Judah, probably after he fled Jerusalem. David's knew his life was danger and that God was protecting Him. David was living knowing who God was in that dangerous situation and it led him to worship.

#### 3) David allowed his worship to lead him into prayer.

Our focus in worship needs to be on our glorious God. We need to be quick, like David, if the Holy Spirit prompts us to respond to God in prayer like feeling the need to pray for someone.
