



HORACE G. WILLIAMS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility: To be eligible for the Horace G. Williams Memorial Scholarship, applications must satisfy the following criteria:

1. Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at the University of Alabama or other institutions of higher education and learning. (Examples: Shelton State, Samford University, Judson College, University of Mobile, etc.)
2. Students enrolled at the University of Alabama must be either a member of an active member of Calvary Baptist Church in Tuscaloosa or under College Membership of Calvary Baptist Church and a member of a church affiliated with The Southern Baptist Convention. Students enrolled at Samford, Judson College, or the University of Mobile must have been a Calvary Baptist Church of Tuscaloosa member prior to beginning college.
3. Have unmet financial needs as determined from information supplied by the applicant concerning financial resources and expected expenses.
4. Ten percent (10%) of the income received each year will be added to the corpus of the Horace G. Williams Scholarship Fund to provide for a systematic growth of the fund. The remaining ninety (90%) of the income received each year will be used to provide one annual scholarship awards. The scholarship awards will normally be of equal value. However, an award may not exceed unmet financial need referred to in item 3 above.
