v. 25 – She can laugh at the days to come	
"I have told you this so that	may be in you
and that your joy may be complete." -Jesus in <u>John 15:11</u>	
3. The Importance of a mother who expresses

v. 11-12 - Her husband has full confidence in her and lacks nothing of value. She brings him good, not harm, all the days of her life.

v. 15 - She gets up while it is still dark; she provides food for her family;	
v. 21 - When it snows, she has no fear for her household; for all of them are clothed in scarlet. v. 27 She watches over the affairs of her household and does not eat the bread of idleness.	
v. 21 She watches over the alians of her household and does not eat the bread of identess.

v. 20 - She opens her arms to the poor and extends her hands to the needy.

v. 24 - She makes linen garments and sells them, and supplies the merchants with sashes.
