

Lifeway Resources Available for Preview


Characters Volume 5: Jesus


Elijah, by Priscilla Shirer


God of Deliverance by Jen Wilkin


Foundations - Old Testament

A 260-day reading plan that includes devotional content and a journaling method designed to enhance understanding, interaction, and application.








How Much More - Lisa Harper


It Begins with Prayer by Dwayne McCrary

Discover a reason to believe that God is not finished with today's generation.







his 8 session study will deepen your understanding of Jesus through biblical, historical, and cultural insight and help you see Him less as an iconic figure and more as an intimate friend.






No More Excuses: A 90-Day Devotional for Men by Tony Evans


Romans From Broken to Belonging




Stories Jesus Told Exploring the heart of the parables






