

## **Packing List**

Bible
Pen and paper
Mask
Sleeping bag (or sheet and blanket)
Pillow
Toiletries (shampoo, soap, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush, etc)
Towel, washcloth, shower shoes
Bug Spray and Sunscreen
Refillable Water Bottle
Clothes for the weekend* - The weather is unpredictable this time of year. Please bring clothing appropriate for warm, cold, and rain.
Shoes - <u>Must have one pair of closed toed shoes</u> for recreation activities (tennis shoes). Can also bring other shoes.
Day bag – a small back pack or bag to carry your bible, pen, etc
Spending money – Students may bring money for snack shack and camp store.

\*Do not pack anything that advertises alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs; explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person; explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations; has spaghetti straps (except for sleepwear); or is excessively short or tight fitting.

**Students can bring cell phones**... We want students to feel free to have their phones for the purpose of communicating with parents and leaders, using Bible app, taking pictures, etc... At the end of the day if a student is using a cell phone in a manner that is disrupting or distracting to themselves or other students, we will ask them to put the phone away. If necessary, leaders may take possession of the phone if they deem it necessary.
