

I'm blown away by what he's accomplished in and through us this year, and I can't wait too see what comes to pass in 2022!






A few quick stats:

- Dedicated 14 children to the Lord




Kara Gasperetti stepped up in as interim lead to help kick-off the Fall.

Megan Robbert joined our team as the Kids Lead in October.









"GROUPS BECOMING FAMILY"

MEET THE HAYNES FAMILY

A year ago, we had one goal in mind: find a local church community and get involved. Having arrived in Snohomish in the middle of a pandemic, we knew that we needed to find a place where we could connect with other believers and find encouragement on Sunday mornings. But we also knew from our experience living internationally that the best way to really get to know people was to open our home and invite people into our lives. When we moved to Sweden (years prior), many Christians graciously opened their homes and hearts to us. Now that we were back in the US, we wanted to be involved in a church that was offering the same caring ministry to people, even in the midst of a pandemic. So, we found Reach, joined the community, and started hosting a small group with another couple.

Since then, our group has been meeting for a big family dinner twice a month, with DNA groups in-between. What started with simple food and discussion has grown into a place for people to authentically share and support one another. We often exchange texts throughout the week and pray for each other. Sometimes the DNA groups even practically serve each other, whether that is making dinner for a couple with a new baby or helping a family with their home remodeling project. For Kip's birthday his DNA group came over to help him move our heavy chicken coop across the yard. When someone is going through marriage counseling, we pray for them, and when someone is sick or dealing with a difficult family situation, we pray for healing and restoration. And when we experience an answered prayer, we celebrate that together too. This is a taste of what the Kingdom of God can be like and we look forward to seeing how God will use this ministry to further His Kingdom in all of our lives.

FROMOBLIFE TO MISSION

In October, we hosted a guest speaker with a powerful story to tell. Michael Franzese is a former member of the infamous Colombo crime family. At his most affluent, he was generating between \$5,000,000.00 to \$8,000,000.00 PER WEEK from both legal and illegal business. In 1986, he was named one of the biggest money earners the mob had seen since Al Capone by Vanity Fair.

Eventually, his lifestyle caught up to him. He was sentenced for his crimes, put in prison, and spent significant time in solitary confinement. It was a hopeless tale until a prison guard slipped him a Bible. After surrendering his life to Jesus, his mission was transformed from building the Columbo Kingdom to building the Kingdom of Heaven.


50 YEARS OF FAITHFUL MINISTRY


