Sundays

- To develop and organise the Sunday teaching programmes, ensuring that they help all the children to grow in their relationship with Jesus in an age appropriate way.
- To set up & pack down the children's groups each week.
- To encourage and develop the volunteer team.
- To help maintain and develop relationships with the children and families who attend on Sunday mornings.
- To help plan guest services including the Family Carol Service, Easter Sunday, Mother's Day etc.
- To encourage children to join in with Kids' Worship and lead the actions.

Admin

- Administrating the kids' team including organising rotas and weekly team emails for Sundays.
- Keeping the Kids' Department page on the church website up to date.

- Registering new children on Churchsuite and communicating with families as needed.

- Leading weekly assemblies in the school.

Community Outreach
