

Dear Awana Parents and Children,

We are so excited to announce that we will be starting Awana back up at Calvary Baptist Church on Wednesday, September 9th! We wanted to reach out to you to let you know of a few changes that will be going on so your child will be ready to come and have a great time learning about Jesus.

First, due to COVID19 restrictions, we will be asking all children EXCEPT for preschoolers to be dropped off in a car drop off lane. This worked well for us during VBS and helped to keep more people out of the buildings. We will not have our traditional opening and closing ceremonies in the gym at this time. Children will come in their designated drop-off spot, be checked in, and then go straight to their classroom.

For pick-up, the procedure will be the same. You will drive through the line where security will have walkie-talkies to call your children down to be picked up. Preschoolers will be picked up a little earlier at 7:45 so that parents may park and so that the traffic flow out of that entrance will be less. Youth (7th-12th) grade will be dropped off/picked up at Entrance C (Gym Entrance) coming in from the Bolling Rd. Entrance

- 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 6th Grade will be dropped off/picked up at Entrance B (Social Room Entrance) coming in through the Bolling Rd. Entrance
- Kindergarten, 2nd, and 4th (and Preschool) will be dropped off/picked up at Entrance A (Office Entrance) coming in through the Ashton Road Entrance

NO CHILDREN OR YOUTH will be let inside the building BEFORE 6:15. This allows our teachers to be in their classrooms before your child arrives.

On the back of this letter you will find a copy of the map so that you can see how the flow of traffic will work. We do ask that you bear with us as we work out any issues.

You will also find a registration form for your child. You can either fill it out and have your child bring it with them on September 9th OR you can register them online at www.cbcr.org. Your child must be pre-registered online OR bring the form with them on the night of Awana. No exceptions.

If your child is a van/bus rider, we need to know ASAP if your child will be coming this year. We are not sure if we will be able to offer this service yet until we know how many children need it. We ask that you call the church office at (252) 537-9828 or email us at awana@calvarybaptistchurchrr.com so that we will know how many children will be riding.

COVID 19 procedures:

- All children will be in their classrooms except for recreation time
- Children may wear a mask if desired, but it is not required
- Hand sanitizer will be available in each classroom
- Snacks will be pre-packaged
- If your child has a fever or any COVID symptoms, has been recently exposed to someone with COVID, or is in any way ill, we ask that you do NOT bring them to Awana.
