		1 <i>1 Samuel 3:2-11</i> Father God, how I long to know you more and to recognize your voice. Tune my ear to your Spirit and deepen my love for you. You are more than just a creator. You are my Father, Savior, and friend.	2 <i>Psalms 100:1-5</i> How great it is to bask in your presence and delight in your praise. You fill my heart with the most profound joy, one not offered by the world. You are pure light and fully good. Let me never grow weary of seeking you.	3 <i>Luke 10:25-37</i> God, help me love my neighbor more. Allow me to see those around me from your perspective and not my own. Give me love and patience toward them, just as you have toward me. Thank you for the gift of community and family; let me not take it for granted.	4 <i>Proverbs 3:5-6</i> Thank you, God, that we can trust in you. We celebrate your holiness and righteousness. Fix our eyes on you and lead in your perfect way with your tender mercy and loving kindness.	5 <i>Psalms 147:1-11</i> Perfect and loving God, our hearts are full of praise for you. You are the maker of heaven and earth, and you are the creator of all good and perfect things. Therefore, we testify of your goodness and rejoice with the angels that you are the only living God and are worthy of praise.
6 <i>Matthew 6:25-34</i> How you love us, Lord! Forgive us when our hearts are consumed with fear and worry and are turned inward on our problems, doubts, or troubles. You are bigger than all these things, and you know what we need. Help us believe that your best for us is better than our own.	7 <i>Isaiah 55:6-9</i> God, we come to you today with hungry hearts. We are searching for the things of you and your kingdom. Reveal yourself to us in great ways and small. Speak to us in shouts and whispers, and tune our ears to recognize your voice.	8 <i>Proverbs 3:13</i> God, we delight in your infinite wisdom and love, and we ask you for an increase of those things in our lives and our hearts. You are the giver of good things, so we come to you with the trust that you will give generously to us as we seek you wholeheartedly.	9 <i>1 Corinthians 9:19-23</i> Lord, we pray for the missionaries worldwide that are becoming all things to all people in your name. We ask that you protect their hearts, minds, and bodies as they work sacrificially to expand your kingdom. We stand with them as their brothers and sisters in Christ.	10 <i>John 1:1-14</i> Father, we thank you for your son Jesus, who came to earth in flesh and blood to become a perfect sacrifice for our sins. We know we are unworthy, and yet, your grace is sufficient. May we never stop rejoicing in your mercy and love.	11 <i>Isaiah 6:1-8</i> God, give us hearts that are willing to go wherever you call us. No matter the sacrifice, no matter the unknown, let us always say “yes” to you. Increase our faith and embolden us to proclaim your gospel wherever we go.	12 <i>John 11:38-44</i> God of resurrection and life, only you can bring light to darkness and overcome death. We ask for resurrection, Lord, over our families, over our relationships, over our passion and desire for you. Bring back to life the things that were lost. We give you glory!
13 <i>Psalms 23:1-6</i> Lord, whatever trouble or pain we may be feeling, we rest in the assurance that it is only a shadow and you are the light that removes all darkness. Thank you that your heart towards me is good, and you desire restoration and healing in all areas of my life.	14 <i>1 John 4:16-19</i> Abide in me, Lord, all the day long. From early morning until I lay my head down to rest, let us enjoy fellowship with one another. Apart from you, there is no good thing, and my desire for you is unquenchable. Thank you that you are near to me and delight in me as I delight in you.	15 <i>Matthew 11:28-30</i> When I am weak, you are strong. Help me let go of everything I am holding on to and fall into your safe and loving arms. Even when I cannot see you, feel you, and when I feel alone, I will keep loving and trusting you, God.	16 <i>Matthew 22:34-40</i> Almighty God, you are the god of abundance, life, kindness, and mercy. You are love! Thank you for the gift of our Savior, Jesus, and the commandments that he taught and gave. Teach us how to love you more and share that love with those around us.	17 <i>John 8:2-11</i> Thank you, Lord, for the gift of forgiveness. Let us also forgive those who have hurt or wounded us. Increase our capacity to receive your love so that we can pour it out to others from a place of abundance.	18 <i>Psalms 63:1-8</i> Oh, how my soul longs for you! My desire is to dwell in your presence, God. You give good things to those who seek after you. Your mercy is new each day, and I rejoice in my inheritance. Thank you for your kingdom, which I am a part of, and thank you for your goodness which I am a recipient of.	19 <i>1 Thessalonians 2:9-13</i> Lord, we long to be a people above reproach as you have called us to be. We confess that we have failed at this time and time again. Help us see clearly when our strongest desire clouds our deepest desire and recognize that we are in need of your salvation and grace.
20 <i>Luke 1:46-55</i> Thank you, God, that you look at our hearts and are drawn to those who fear you. Thank you for pursuing us even when we were your enemies. We thank you that we are no longer separated and stuck in sin, but in you, there is deliverance. You are a healer, and we give you glory.	21 <i>Philippians 4:4-14</i> We thank you that you are not a God who is far away. You are right here in our midst ministering to us. Our hearts are full of gratitude for your goodness and mercy. Let us be filled to the point of overflowing so that all those around us will know of your great love.	22 <i>Isaiah 40:27-31</i> Lord, forgive us for the times when we allow our circumstances to overwhelm us and we lose sight of you. Increase our faith, God. You are safe and steady, eternal and right. It is you who gives strength to the weary and power to the weak.	23 <i>1 John 5:1-12</i> We rejoice today that we have eternal life through the sacrifice of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. We are humbled by this undeserved gift. Give us opportunities to tell others about this great gift and demonstrate your love by loving our neighbors.	24 <i>Matthew 14:22-33</i> Father, thank you for choosing to be in a relationship with us. Give us a burning desire to seek time alone with you because from it comes strength, faith, and confidence in who you are. Bring order to our desires and longings so that you may be glorified in our actions and words.	25 <i>Colossians 1:9-14</i> Lord, we lift up our brothers and sisters in Christ. We ask that you give them ears to hear your voice and spirits ready to respond. We pray for their safety, endurance in difficult times, and for the knowledge, that you are a safe resting place. We give you glory, for all good things are found in you.	26 <i>Matthew 25:35-40</i> Father, we thank you for the gift of community and their role in our spiritual formation. Let us give to others as we have been given. Let us love as we have been loved. All your children are precious to you, so give us eyes of mercy and hearts of love toward them.
27 <i>1 Corinthians 12:12-20</i> God, we ask for an increase in our capacity to love and appreciate our brothers and sisters in Christ. Help us celebrate our differences and recognize that the body is stronger because of them. Thank you that you have uniquely made each of us in your image and for your glory.	28 <i>Luke 19:1-10</i> Lord, thank you that you go after the sinner, for we were all once lost, and you have redeemed us. Give us hearts like yours, full of love and mercy for the lost around us.
